The following described real estate situated in the village of Rushsylvania, Rushcreek Township, Logan County, Ohio and more particularly described as follows; V.M.S. 9909

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Sandusky Street (C.H.No.9) at the Southeast corner of Donald E. Corwin's 5.20 acre tract as shown on page 51 of the Logan County Engineer's Field Book No. 578; thence with the centerline of said Sandusky Street South $36^{\circ}-26'$ West 100.0 feet to an iron pin, said pin being the Northeast corner of Ruth R. Kramer's 0.38 acre tract; thence with said Kramer's north line North $66^{\circ}-17'$ West 194.7 feet to an iron pin at the Northwest corner of said Kramer tract; thence North $36^{\circ}-26'$ East 100.0 feet to a point in Corwin's south line; thence with Corwin's south line South $66^{\circ}-17'$ East 194.7 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.45 of an acre more or less.
