

## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR TONY VANCE 1.881 ACRES January 20, 2020

Vance's and Cheri S. Vance's 24.98 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 51, page 444, said 1.881 acre tract more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron bar set in the southwesterly line of Bank Street (60 feet wide) at the easternmost corner of lot 210 as shown on the plat of D.D. and A.M. Fawcett's Addition to the Village of Rushylvania recorded in Plat Cabinet A, Slide 175 and conveyed to James Daniel Mitchell and Jo Ann Mitchell in Deed Volume 332, page 253, said iron bar also at a northern corner of said 24.98 acre tract;

Thence **South 53°12'40" East 330.12 feet** following the southwesterly line of Bank Street and the northeasterly line of said 24.98 acre tract, to an iron bar set;

Thence **South 36°23′52" West 176.67 feet**, departing from the southwesterly line of Bank Street and entering said 24.98 acre tract, to an iron bar set;

Thence North 63°10'22" West 335.43 feet to an iron bar set;

Thence **South 53°10′16″ East 204.45 feet**, departing from the southeasterly line of said Conrail railroads tract, following the southwesterly line of said 16 feet wide alley and a northeasterly line of said 24.98 acre tract, to a 5/8 inch iron bar found;

Thence **North 36°49'44" East 166.00 feet**, following the southeasterly line of said 16 feet wide alley, the southeasterly line of said Lot 210 and a northwesterly line of said 24.98 acre tract, to the **place of beginning, containing 1.881 acres** more or less and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.




