The following described real estate situated in the Village of Russells Point, Washington Township, Logan County, Ohio and more particularly described as follows:

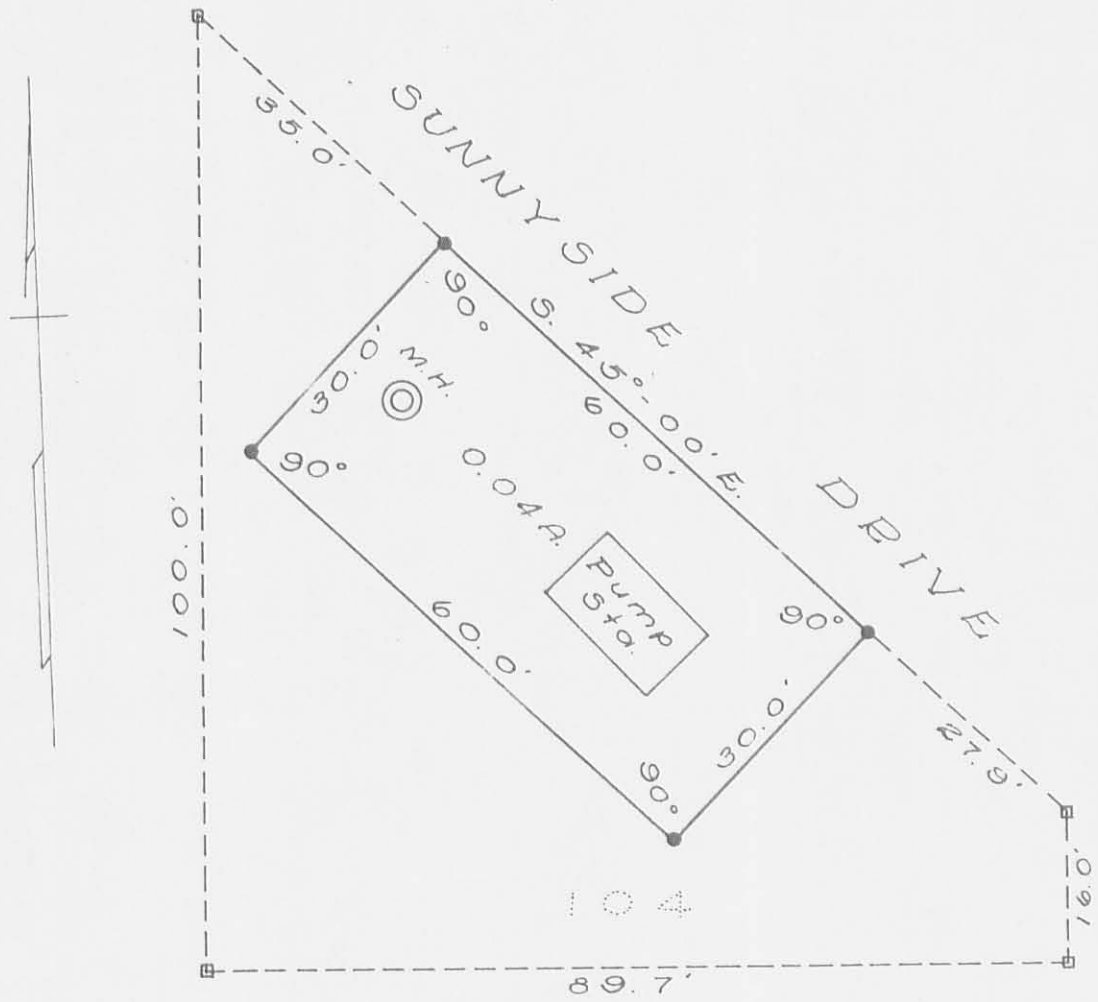
Commencing at a stone in the line between Section 35, Town 6, South, Range 8 East and Section 36, Town 6 South, Range 8 East and in center of State Route #720 as shown on page 42-3 in Logan County Engineer's Field Book #589; thence with the Center Line of said State Route #720 North $82^{\circ}-58'$ West 270.2 feet to an iron pin; thence South $31^{\circ}-02'$ West 242.5 feet to an iron pin in the south line of State Route #720 and Sunnyside Drive for the beginning point of this description; thence South $45^{\circ}-00'$ West 30.0 feet to an iron pin; thence North $45^{\circ}-00'$ West 60.0 feet to an iron pin; thence North $45^{\circ}-00'$ East ^{feet} 30.0 to an iron pin in the south line of State Route #720 and Sunnyside Drive; thence along the south side of said road South $45^{\circ}-00'$ East 60.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.04 of an acre more or less.
