Hoffman (Official Records Volume 924, Page 163, Parcel 2);

Thence North 10°19'10" West, passing through said 25.765-acre parcel on a course with the east line of lands formerly occupied by the Penn Central Corporation, a distance of 444.17 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar (found) at an angle point in the boundary of said 25.765-acre parcel;

Thence North 10°19'10" West, now with a boundary of said 25.765-acre parcel, and now also with the east line of a 13.92-acre tract of land granted to the Logan County Commissioners (Deed Volume 402, Page 848), a distance of 193.85 feet to a point in the centerline of the Great Miami River, being also an angle point in the boundary of said 25.765-acre parcel, and the POINT OF BEGINNING [this point bears S 14°25'43"W, 202.92 feet from a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set in an adjacent field as a reference point)];

Thence North 10°18'05" West, with the east line of said 13.92-acre tract, a distance of 230.45 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar (found) at an angle point in the boundary of said 13.92-acre tract;

Thence South 89°19'17" East, with a jog in the east line of said 13.92-acre tract, a distance of 17.32 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar (found) at an angle point in the boundary of said 13.92-acre tract;

Thence North 10°18'05" West, with the east line of said 13.92-acre tract, a distance of 1194.00 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar (found) at an angle point in the boundary of said 13.92-acre tract;

Thence North 89°19'17" West, with a jog in the east line of said 13.92-acre tract, a distance of 17.32 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar (found) at an angle point in the boundary of said 13.92-acre tract;

Thence North 10°18'05" West, with the east line of said 13.92-acre tract, a distance of 186.86 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set);

Thence North 79°42'18" East, with a new division line, a distance of 381.11 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set);

Thence North 69°15'13" East, with a new division line, a distance of 197.99 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set);

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Thence North 18°42'00" East, with a new division line, a distance of 225.87 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set);

Thence North 00°46'48" East, with a new division line, a distance of 717.97 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set) at the southwest corner of a 6.838-acre tract recently surveyed as a land transfer from Major Properties, Inc. to John E. Rudolph, Trustee and Mary M. Rudolph, Trustee (Official Records Volume \_\_\_\_, Page \_\_\_\_; see also, K&K Drawing Number L-1322);

Thence North 69°18'31" East, with the south line of said 6.838-acre tract, a distance of 642.87 feet to a point in the centerline of the Great Miami River, which point is the southeast corner of said 6.838-acre tract [at 400.00 feet, this course passes through a 3/4-inch iron pipe (set on line as a reference point)];

Thence South 01°36'15" East, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 612.20 feet to a point;

Thence South 14°09'22" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 224.93 feet to a point;

Thence South 37°30'18" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 344.68 feet to a point;

Thence South 15°05'07" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 381.87 feet to a point;

Thence South 11°10'27" East, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 155.10 feet to a point;

Thence South 06°49'11" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 340.12 feet to a point;

Thence South 28°14'17" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of a 2.972-acre tract granted to Kimberly K. Hoffman (Official Records Volume 1045, Page 811), a distance of 756.91 feet to a point;

Thence South 38°38'54" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 306.62 feet to a point;

Thence South 73°40'48" West, with the centerline of the Great Miami River and the west line of said 555.321-acre tract, a distance of 50.55 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.



The lands herein described comprise a gross area of 37.099 acres, of which no area is subject to any present roadway, thus leaving a net area also of 37.099 acres; subject to any easements of record at the time of the recording of this instrument.

It is understood that the 81.50-acre tract granted to Major Properties, Inc. by Deed Volume 370, Page 422 has had several splits since that deed was recorded, and the remainder lands now comprise 62.086 acres, being known as Logan County Tax Parcel #52-032-00-00-018-000.

NOTE: This area of 62.086 acres was most previously shown in the county auditor's records as 68.924 acres, but herein accounts for the deduction of the 6.838-acre tract called for in the above description.

This description is based on an actual field survey performed in November 2012 under the supervision of Michael G. Buettner, Ohio Registered Professional Surveyor No. 6881. Bearings are based on the grid of the North Zone of the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, which renders a bearing of North 89°33'37" West for the south line of said Section 1. Iron pipes set this survey are 3/4-inch diameter by 30-inch long, and are capped with an orange plastic "K&K/LIMA" plug.
