

The Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, met in regular session on this date 21st day of January, 1957, with the following members present: Mr. Clyde F. Kennedy, President, Mr. Harley H. Lane, Vice-President, and Mr. Hugh Roebuck,

Mr. Hugh Roebuck made the motion for the adoption of the following resolution:

IN THE MATTER OF FILING A PETITION FOR THE STREET RELOCATION OF PINE STREET IN LAKESIDE ALLOTMENT, STOKES TOWNSHIP, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on January 21st, 1957, at 11:30 A. M., a Street Relocation Petition was filed with the said Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, by twelve freeholders or more signing the Petition that was submitted to the said Board of County Commissioners, and described as follows:

Pine Street, as shown on the recorded plat of Lakeside Allotment, between Lot #45 and Lot #46, running south-easterly from State Street, is to be vacated.

Pine Street is to be relocated and is to be 30 feet off of the northeast side of Lot #45, running southeasterly from State Street.

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, have fixed the 23rd day of February, 1957, at 10 o'clock, A. M., as the time for the view thereon, and also the 2nd day of March, 1957, at ten o'clock A. M., at the office of said Board of County Commissioners as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition, and IT WAS THEREFORE

RESOLVED, the said Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, having set the date for the view of the proposed improvement, and also a date for the hearing thereon, will give notice by publication of the time and place for both such view and hearing, once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in Logan County, Ohio, and will state briefly the character of such improvement, according to Ohio Revised Code Section No. 5553. 05, and

The Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, met in regular session on this date April 27, 1959, with the following members present: Mr. Clyde F. Kennedy, President, Mr. Foster Cole, Vice-President, and Mr. William Fox.

Mr. William Fox made the motion for the adoption of the following resolution:

IN THE MATTER OF THE ADJOURNED HEARING ON THE PINE STREET, LAKESIDE ALLOTMENT, STOKES TOWNSHIP, PETITION, TO VACATE AND RELOCATE.

WHEREAS, on March 2, 1957 the first hearing on this petition for the vacating and relocation on Pine Street, Lakeside Allotment, Stokes Township, Logan County, Ohio, was adjourned until a later date, until the hearing was held on the Houchins-Slough Ditch as the petitioners thought it would be cheaper to wait until this Houchins-Slough Ditch was cleaned out; but the petition was dismissed on the Houchins-Slough Ditch, therefore there would be no benefits to the vacating and relocating Pine Street, and

WHEREAS, the adjourned hearing was advertised in the Bellefontaine Daily Examiner for two consecutive weeks, and the landowners carrying the petition were notified by mail as to the hearing to be held on April 27th, 1959, on this said Pine Street petition to vacate and relocate, and

WHEREAS, the Logan County Engineer, H. D. Keller, submitted his report stating he had viewed the site of the proposed relocation, being 30 feet off of the north side of Lot No. 45 in said Lakeside Allotment, extending from State Street southeasterly to State Route 69; and it was the Engineer's opinion that the proposed relocation would be conducive to public welfare and should be established 30 feet in width, and

IT WAS THEREFORE

RESOLVED, and the said Board of County Commissioners do hereby grant the prayers of the petitioners, that Pine Street, as shown on the recorded plat of Lakeside Allotment, between Lot #45 and Lot #46 running southeasterly from State Street is to be vacated; and Pine Street is to be relocated and is to be 30 feet off of the northeast side of Lot #45, running southeasterly from State Street, as this relocation will be for the public convenience and welfare, and

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Mr. Foster Cole seconded this motion and the roll call being called on its adoption resulted as follows:
