## ALEXANDER SURVEY

### February 1, 1999

The following described real estate situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Stokes, being part of the east half of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 33, Town 6, Range 8 E., and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a R. R. spike found in the centerline of State Route 720 and the north line of the southwest fractional quarter of said Sec. 33 at the northwest corner of Charles O. Marker, et al's 1.87 acre tract as described in D. B. Vol. 398 Page 387.

Thence with said Marker's west line S. 0° 15' 01" E. 263.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar found, passing a 1/2 inch iron bar found at 30.07 feet.

Thence WEST 49.73 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set.

Thence S. 1° 14' 59" W. 277.53 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set.

Thence WEST 918.11 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set in the east line of Austin E. Smith, et al's 94.74 acre tract as described in O. R. Vol. 107 page 272.

Thence with said Smith's east line N. 0° 22' 43" W. 540.48 feet to a magnetic nail set in the centerline of said S. R. 720 and the north line of the southwest fractional quarter of said Sec. 33, passing a 5/8 inch iron bar set at 510.48 feet, said magnetic nail set being EAST 1336.06 feet from a monument box with stone found at the northwest corner of the southwest fractional quarter of said Sec. 33.

Thence with the centerline of said S. R. 720 and the north line of the southwest fractional quarter of said Sec. 33 EAST 976.32 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 11.766 acres more or less of which 0.672 acre is in the right of way of State Route 720.

The above described 11.766 acre tract being in the north part of Bob Max Alexander's 94.44 acre tract as described in D. B. Vol. 291 page 396.



Beginning for reference at a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "OHIO DOT SURVEY PT" in a monument box at the intersection of the centerline of State Route 720 (60' R/W) with the south terminus point of the centerline of Township Road 84, said iron pin referenced as Station 14+79 (ahead) in Logan County Engineer's survey index number 1722 in Stokes Township survey records, and said iron pin being in the west line of Section 33, Town 6, Range 8 and in the east line of Section 32, Town 6, Range 8;

Thence North 90°00'00" East (assumed bearing) 1335.96 feet, entering said Section 33 and following the centerline of State Route 720 and the east-west half section line of said Section 33, to a magnetic nail found at the northwest corner of said 11.766 acre tract and at the northeast corner of Bruce and Connie Smith's 94.74 acre Tract No. 2 described in Official Record 859, page 499;

Thence North 90°00'00" East 723.81 feet, continuing with the centerline of State Route 720 and the east-west half section line of said Section 33, following the north line of said 11.766 acre tract, to a magnetic nail set and marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence North 90°00'00" East 252.52 feet, continuing with the centerline of State Route 720, the east-west half section line of said Section 33, and the north line of said 11.766 acre tract, to a railroad spike found at the northwest corner of Charles O. and Georgia A. Marker's 1.87 acre tract described in Deed Record 398, page 387;

Thence South 00°15'23" East 262.99 feet, departing from the centerline of said Road, following the west line of said 1.87 acre tract and an east line of said 11.766 acre tract, passing at 30.06 feet a ½ inch iron pin found, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "L. GEESLIN S5248" in a north line of Elizabeth Alexander Sederstrom's 80.804 acre tract described in Official Record 437, page 499;

Thence South 89°59'54" West 49.73 feet, following a north line of said 80.804 acre tract and a south line of said 11.766 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 01°16'20" West 277.42 feet, following a west line of said 80.804 acre tract and an east line of said 11.766 acre tract, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "L. GEESLIN S5248";

Thence South 89°58'42" West 197.81 feet, following a north line of said 80.804 acre tract and a south line of said 11.766 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 00°00'00" West 540.41 feet, crossing said 11.766 acre tract and passing at 510.41 feet an iron pin set, to the place of beginning, containing 2.807 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions recorded. Of the above described 2.807 acre tract, 0.174 acre is within the right of way of State Route 720.

Beginning for reference at a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "OHIO DOT SURVEY PT" in a monument box at the intersection of the centerline of State Route 720 (60' R/W) with the south terminus point of the centerline of Township Road 84, said iron pin referenced as Station 14+79 (ahead) in Logan County Engineer's survey index number 1722 in Stokes Township survey records, and said iron pin being in the west line of Section 33, Town 6, Range 8 and in the east line of Section 32, Town 6, Range 8;

Thence North 90°00'00" East (assumed bearing) 1335.96 feet, entering said Section 33 and following the centerline of State Route 720 and the east-west half section line of said Section 33, to a magnetic nail found at the northwest corner of said 11.766 acre tract and at the northeast corner of Bruce and Connie Smith's 94.74 acre Tract No. 2 described in Official Record 859, page 499, said magnetic nail marking the **place of beginning**;
