Kress, Trustee, as recorded in Official Record 132, Page 364, Tract 2, of the records of Logan County to a 1 1/2 inch iron pipe found, said pipe being the principal point of beginning of the herein described tract;

Thence, continue South 87 degrees 25' 26" East, 83.98 feet along the southerly boundary line of said Kress tract to a 1 inch iron pipe found;

Thence, South 4 degrees 59' 23" East, 139.05 feet along the westerly boundary line of a 0.21 acre tract and a 0.13073 acre tract, both now owned by JD-One JD-Two, Inc., as recorded in Official Record 137, Page 157 and Official Record 236, Page 892 of the records of Logan County, to a point on the face of a seawall, at the water's edge of Indian Lake, reference the township line at 136.70 feet and, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found at 128.88 feet;

Thence, South 45 degrees 42' 36" West, 62.21 feet along the face of said seawall, at the water's edge to a point;

Thence, South 58 degrees 02' 07" West, 19.33 feet along the face of said seawall, at the water's edge to a point;






The starting bearing, North 7 degrees 47' 00" West, along the centerline of Township Road No.253, is based on an assumed meridian and is used only to denote angles.
