

Yoder Survey Union Township July 1954 1.00 Acre

The following described land in Union Township, Logan County Ohio and being in Section 4 Town 4 Range 13

Being one acre out of the N.W. corner of the N.W. Quarter of section 4 town 4 range 13 and also being out of the N.W. corner of Paul D. Yoder's 63.76 acre tract and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a re-survey monument at the N.W. corner of the N.W. quarter of said section 4 and being in the center of State Highway Number 726 (State Route Number 508) known as the West Liberty and DeGraff Pike and said beginning point also being in the center of County Road Number 187 known as the Garade Pike thence with the center line of State Highway Number 726 S. 84 - 47 E. 218.7 feet to an iron thence S. 5 - 13 W. 199.1 feet to an iron pipe the last described line passing an iron at the south side of the State Highway at 30.00 feet thence N. 84 - 47 W. 218.7 feet to an iron in the center of County Highway Number 187 the last described line passing an iron pipe at the west side of County Highway Number 187 at 198.7 feet thence with the center of said County Highway known as the Garade Pike N. 5 - 13 E. 199.1 feet to the place of beginning said described land containing one acre.
