
## ROTHHAR SURVEY SEC. 14, T. 7 S, R. 8 E. WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP January 8, 1955

R. #27h, N. 89°-48' W. 78h.1 feet to an iron pin, said iron pin being the beginning point of this description; thence S. 0°-31' W. 427.3 feet to a stake; thence N. 89°-48' W. 68.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0°-39' W. 550.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87°-42' W. 481.9 feet to an iron pin in the East line of a 155.50 acre tract presently belonging to Orville F. Brandt; thence with said Brandt's East line N. 0°-31' E. 959.9 feet to an iron pin in the center of said S. R. #27h; thence with said center line S. 89°-48' E.
