Lying in Section 35, Town 6, Range 8, Village of Russells Point, Washington Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being out of the Dayton Power and Light Company 5.39 acre tract as deeded and described in Official Record 329, Page 713, Parcel No. 10 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on a railroad spike found on the intersection of the centerline of Township Road 239 and the south right-of-way of U.S. Route 33.

THENCE, with the south right-of-way of U.S. Route 33 (variable widths), the following two courses:

S 83° -09'-10"E, a distance of 278.03 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 20.58 feet.

THENCE, with the north line of the Logan County Commissioners 0.048 acre tract (Vol. 402, Pg. 848), S 88°-02'-50"W, a distance of 106.65 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the northerly line of the Charles L. Williams 3.70 acre tract (O.R. 61, Pg. 213, Tract No. 1), with a curve to the left, having a radius of 3769.75 feet, a central angle of 00°-26'-32", an arc length of 29.09 feet, and a chord bearing N 58°-34'-52"W, a distance of 29.09 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the northerly lines of the said 3.70 acre tract, the Charlie L. Williams 16.02 acre tract (O.R. 61, Pg. 213, Tract No. 2) and the Frances E. Longbrake 2.85 acre tract (O.R. 806, Pg. 498, Parcel No. 2), with a curve to the left, having a radius of 4724.71 feet, a central angle of 24°-19'-26", an arc length of 2005.80 feet and a chord bearing N 70°-55'-54"W, a distance of 1990.77 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.


