Beginning for reference at a harrow tooth found in the centerline of County Road #91 (50 feet wide) at PI Sta. 26+97 as shown on Logan County Road 91 R/W Plans, page 1 of 5, said harrow tooth being in the east-west half section line of Section 19, Town 7, Range 9, at a northeast corner of the remainder of Fred and Barbara Kuba's original 29.63 acre tract described in Deed Volume 368, page 744, and at the east corner of Kurtis P. Hoffman's 2 acre Tract I described in Official Record 630, page 677;

Thence North 56°06'59" West (assumed bearing) 550.63 feet, following the centerline of said Road and the northeast line of said 2 acre tract, passing at approximately 534 feet the east line of said Section 24, and the northeast corner of Kurtis P. Hoffman's 0.750 acre Tract II described in Official Record 630, page 677, and thereafter entering said Section 24 and also following the northeast line of said 0.750 acre tract, to a railroad spike found at the eastern corner of said 4.61 acre tract and marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence South 29°53'21" West 365.00 feet, passing at 25.06 feet an iron pin set, following the northwest line of said 0.750 acre tract and the southeast line of said 4.61 acre tract, to an iron pin set in the eastwest half section line of said Section 24 and in the north line of the remainder of said original 29.63 acre tract;

Thence **South 89°44'28" West 129.69 feet**, following the south line of said 4.61 acre tract, the north line of the remainder of said original 29.63 acre tract and the east-west half section line of said Section 24, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "L. GEESLIN S. 5248" in a curve in the northeast line of Dayton Power and Light's 45.250 acre Parcel No. 9 described in Official Record 329, page 713 (said property formerly railroad property);

Thence following a curve to the right in the northeast line of said 45.250 acre tract and in the southwest line of said 4.61 acre tract for a distance of 23.67 feet, said curve having a radius of 2814.83 feet, a tangent of 11.84 feet and a delta of 0°28'55", the chord of which bears **North 30°15'33" West 23.67 feet**, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 29°53'21" East 427.62 feet, departing from said curve in the northeast line of said 45.250 acre tract and crossing said 4.61 acre tract, passing at 402.56 feet an iron pin set, to a magnetic nail set in the centerline of said Road;

Thence South 56°06'59" East 133.00 feet, following the centerline of said Road and a northeast line of said 4.61 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 1.238 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record. Of the above described 1.238 acre tract, 0.076 acre is within the right of way of County Road #91.




