Thence South- 56^{O} -23'-38"-East (this bearing is the basis of bearing and is assumed) 211.27 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron bar found in the west line of Mildred L. Fullerton's 34.00 acre tract as described in Official Records Volume 35, Pages 503 and 504, passing through a 5/8 inch diameter iron bar set in the centerline of said railroad at 105.64 feet;

Thence with Mildred L. Fullerton's west line South-110-09'-34"-East 651.95 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron bar set;

Thence South-78 O-50'-26"-West 150.00 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron bar set in the east line of said Lottie McKinnon addition, passing through a 5/8 inch diameter iron bar set in the centerline of said railroad at 75.00 feet;

Thence with the east line of said addition North- 11° -09'-34"-West 800.73 feet to the place of beginning.

This description is based upon a field survey performed on November 3 and November 24, 1990.






