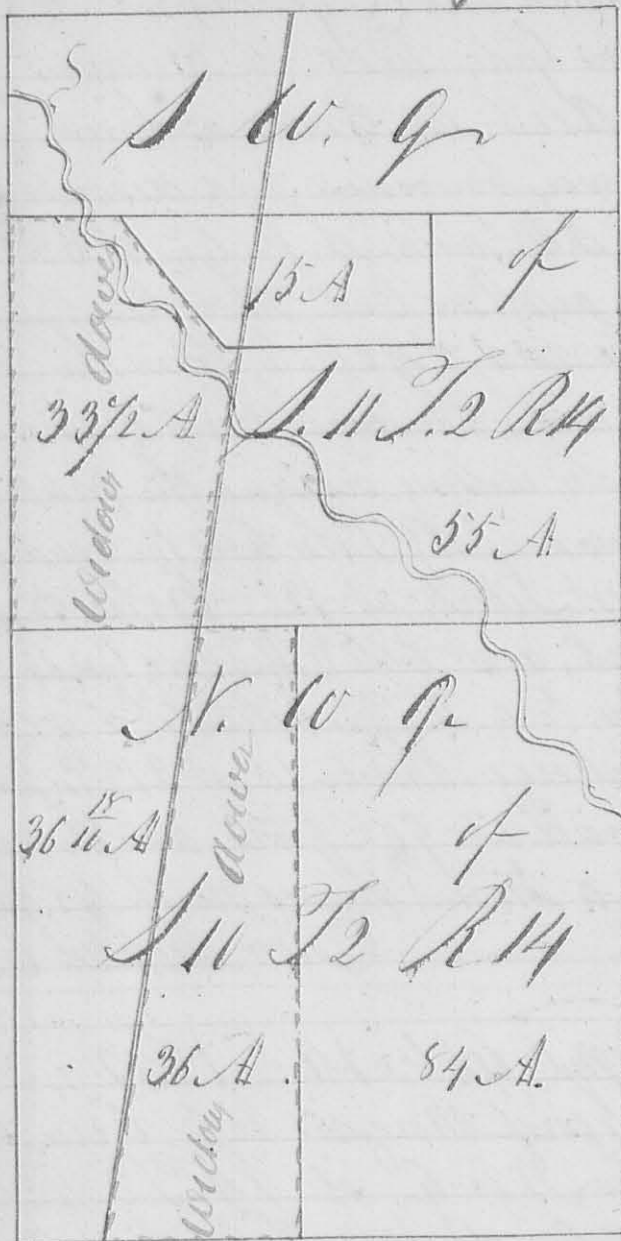

by an Order of partition &  
Award of the Court of  
Common Pleas Logan County  
Ohio at the April Term  
1842 the following  
described real estate as  
mentioned in said order  
to wit: being part of the  
N. 10 Q. of S. 11 T. 2 R. 14  
beginning at the N.E.  
cor. of said Q. Sec.  
thence N 10° 15' poles  
to its S.E. corner;  
thence with the south  
line thereof N 89° E  
135 1/2 poles to a stake  
in the middle of the  
State road leading from

Present bearing N 1° E 3/4  
Logansville to H. Johns S.E. cor. to Tullis & Bayles  
lot of 36 1/2 acres in said Q. section; thence with  
their East line and road N 10° E 1/2 poles, to a stake  
in the middle of said road in the S.E. line their N.E.  
Cor. thence with said line N 89° E 109 1/2 poles crossing  
a creek to the beginning containing 120 acres

Set off 36 acres from the west end of said lot  
for the widow Alford - Beginning at Tullis &  
Bayles N.E. cor. in said Q. section; thence with  
the Sec. line N 89° E 23 1/2 poles to a stake from  
which a white oak 2 1/2 feet in diameter bears S 5° E  
6 1/2 links; thence S 2° W 157 poles, to a stake in a

 at the S. W. cor of Sec. 11: thence with the  
 south line thereof  $S 89^{\circ} 10' 51''$  poles passing  
 the N. E. cor of Tullis & Bayless' lot of 36<sup>th</sup> acres  
 & crossing a creek, to the S. E. cor of said G. Sec.  
 thence with the east line thereof  $N 1^{\circ} 10'$  poles  
 thence  $N 89^{\circ} 10' 51''$  poles, to the N. E. cor of Adam  
 Jennings' lot of 15 acres thence with his east line  
 $S 1^{\circ} 10' 34''$  poles to his S. E. cor. thence with his  
 south line  $N 89^{\circ} 10' 53''$  poles crossing the State road lead-  
 ing from Loganville to St. John, to his S. W. cor: thence  
 with his west line  $N 38^{\circ} 10' 44''$  poles to a stake on the  
 east bank of a creek his N. W. corner: thence  $N 89^{\circ} 10'$   
 25 poles crossing the creek at 8 poles to the west line of  
 said G. Sec. (Section line) thence with said line  $S 1^{\circ} 10'$   
 108 poles, to the beginning containing 90 acres deduct  
 ing therefrom 1/2 acre for mill privileges (88 1/2 acres)

Lot of 35<sup>th</sup> acres from the west end of said lot  
 for the common closure: - Beg. at the S. W. cor. to said
