Jones et al as recorded in Official Record No. 211 Page 317 (11-8-1993), passing through a 5/8 inch Rebar found at 224.70 feet at the northwest corner to Donn Gail Dague's present 2.480 Acre tract as recorded in Official Record No. 94 Page 371 (10-10-1989);

Thence with the centerline of C. H. No. 13, S. 79°17'55" E. 499.00 feet to a R. R. Spike set, passing through a P. K. Nail found at 72.00 feet, (said P. K. Nail being Station No. 399+00.00 of the centerline survey of C. H. No. 13 as shown in Logan County Engineers Field Book No. 598 Page 58);

Thence S. $5^{\circ}59'47"$ W. 629.98 feet to a R. R. Spike set in the centerline of T. R. No. 247, which is also the Greeville treaty Line, passing through a 5/8" x 30" Rebar set at 25.08 feet and a 5/8" x 30" Rebar set at 614.43 feet;

Thence with the centerline of T. R. No. 247 and the Greenville Treaty Line, S. 80°42'00" W. 294.40 feet to the place of beginning, (Note: The centerline of T. R. No. 247 is the Basis of Bearing for thi survey - S. 80°42'00" W.), containing 385,939.905 square feet or 8.860 Acres, more or less.

Of the above described tract, there is 17,125.00 square feet or 0.393 Acres in the right of ways of C. H. No. 13 and T. R. No. 247.
