## CEMETERY TRUSTEES 57.766 ACRES

Lying in Section 28, Town 5, Range 13, Liberty Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being all of the Trustees of Fairview Cemetery original 57 acre tract as deeded and described in Volume 125, Page 234 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at the intersection of the center-lines of County Highway 14 and County Highway 189.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 189 (60 feet wide), N 12°-30'-14" W, a distance of 141.82 feet to a railroad spike found.

THENCE, with the south line of the Shirley L. Brandt 5.30 acre tract (O.R. 309, Pg. 184), S 84°-41'-29" E, a distance of 405.87 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 31.58 feet.

THENCE, with the south line of the remainder of the Lewis W. Broshes original 53 acre tract (Vol. 200, Pg. 50) and crossing U.S. Route 68, S 84°-56'-02" E, a distance of 354.70 feet to a concrete right-of-way monument found.

THENCE, with the south line of the Vivian C. Dodge 13.66 acre tract (Vol. 395, Pg. 751), S 86°-22'-33" E, a distance of 984.64 feet to a MAG nail set, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 954.39 feet.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 5 (60 feet wide), S 3°-45'-58" E, a distance of 913.59 feet to a 1-1/4 inch iron pipe found.

THENCE, continuing with the center-line of County Highway 5, S 1°-11'-38" W, a distance of 199.85 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, continuing with the center-line and the center-line extended of County Highway 5, S 16°-58'-49" W, a distance of 591.10 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the north line of the Corporation of the Village of West Liberty and the north line of the original Fairview Cemetery and crossing U.S. Route 68, N 82°-23'-45" W, a distance of 1186.40 feet to a P.K. nail found, passing 5/8 inch iron rods set at 180.46 feet and 1153.82 feet.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 189 and the Corporation line of the Village of West Liberty, N 15°-20'-14" W, a distance of 499.69 feet to a P.K. nail found.

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THENCE, continuing with the center-line of County Highway 189 and the Corporation Line, N 15°-26'-02" W, a distance of 1069.07 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 57.766 acres of which 12.370 acres are within the highway rights of way.

The basis for bearings is the center-line of County Highway 189, north of County Highway 14, being N 12°-30'-14" W, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Co., Inc. on November 16, 2000.

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION - AREA TO BE ANNEXED - 57.766 ACRE TRACT**

Being situate in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Liberty, and being a part of Section 28, Town 5, Range 13, B.T.M.R.S., and being more particularly described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at a Railroad Spike found at the intersection of the centerlines of Township Road 14 (60' right-of-way) and Township Road 189 (60' right-of-way);

thence with the centerline of Township Road 189 & the existing corporation line, N-12°39'47"-W, 141.62'(feet) to a Railroad Spike found at the Southwest corner of a 1.411 acre tract conveyed to John and Lauren Krabill by deed recorded in Official Record 1223, Page 288;

thence with the South line of said Krabill's tract, S-84°51'02"-E, 405.87'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found at the Southwest corner of an original 53 acre tract conveyed to Lewis W. Broshes by deed recorded in Deed Volume 200, Page 50;

thence with the South line of said Broshes' tract and crossing U.S. Route 68, S-85°05'35"-E, 354.70'(feet) to a concrete right-of-way monument found on the East line of said U.S. Route 68 at the Southwest corner of a 13.66 acre tract conveyed to West Liberty Garden Apartments by deed recorded in Official Record 990, Page 607, Parcel 1;

thence with the South line of said 13.66 acre tract, S-86°32'06"-E, 984.64'(feet) to a Mag Nail found on the centerline of County Road 5 (60' right-of-way), passing for reference a 5/8" diameter iron bar found at 954.39'(feet);

thence with the centerline of County Road 5 the following three (3) courses:

- S-3°55'31"-E, 913.59'(feet) to a 1.25" diameter iron pipe found;
- S-1°02'05"-W, 199.85'(feet) to a 3/4" diameter iron bar found;
- S-16°49'12"-W, 591.09'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found within the right-of-way of aforementioned U.S. Route 68 at the Northeast corner of Fairview Cemetery;

thence with the North line of the original Fairview Cemetery being an original 20 acre tract conveyed to the President, Recorder and Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Liberty Ohio as deeded in Deed Volume 49, page 453 and the existing corporation line of the Village of West Liberty, N-82°33'18"-W, 1186.40'(feet) to a point on the centerline of aforementioned Township Road 189, passing for reference a 5/8" diameter iron bar found at 180.46'(feet), the West right-of-way line of U.S. Route 68 at 183.97'(feet) and a 5/8" diameter iron bar found on the right-of-way line of Township Road 189 at 1153.62'(feet);

thence with the centerline of Township Road 189 and the existing corporation line, N-15°29'47"-W, 499.69'(feet) to a P.K. Nail found;

thence continuing with the centerline of Township Road 189 and the existing corporation line, N-15°35'35"-W, 1089.07'(feet) to the place of beginning.

Containing 57.766 acres, 12.370 acres of which is within the Roads rights-of-ways, but being subject to the rights of all legal highways and all easements of record.

Being all of a 57 acre tract conveyed to Trustees of Fairview Cemetery by deed recorded in Deed Volume 125, Page 234, of the Logan County Deed Records.
