

DORIS JEAN AND JOHN MANN BUTLER SURVEY 112.220 ACRES November 3, 2006

The following described 112.220 acre tract of land is situated in Virginia Military Survey 3155, Zane Township, Logan County, Ohio and being all of Doris Jean and John Mann Butler, Trustee's 113.0 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 246, page 157, said 112.220 acre tract more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at the intersection of the centerline of County Road 153 (60 feet wide) with the southeast line of V.M.S. 3155 and the northwest line of V.M.S. 3160, said railroad spike also marking the southernmost corner of said 113.0 acre tract and the westernmost corner of Carol W. and Charolet L. Losey's Tract II, 84.11 acres, described in Official Record Volume 4, page 927;

Thence North 37°00'00" West 1497.53 feet, entering V.M.S. 3155, following the centerline of County Road 153 and the southwest line of said 113.0 acre tract, to a railroad spike found at the southernmost corner of Alan D. and Carolyn M. Brown, Trustee's 39.0 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 338, page 928;

Thence **North 57°58'30"** East 3487.56 feet, departing from the centerline of County Road 153, following the northwest line of said 113.0 acre tract, the southeast line of said 39.0 acre tract, and the southeast line of Gerald D. and Hazel A. Lawruk's 76.220 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 520, page 768, passing an iron pin set at 30.11 feet, a stone found at 1621.61 feet, and a 5/8 inch iron pin found at 3446.42 feet, to a point in the centerline of Big Darby Creek and in the southwest line of Nippon Express U.S.A., Inc.'s 82.458 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 86, page 29;

Thence South 23°00'56" East 1483.63 feet, following the centerline of Big Darby Creek, the northeast line of said 113.0 acre tract, the southwest line of said 82.458 acre tract, and the southwest line of The Nature Conservancy's 74.837 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 469, page 506, to a point in the southeast line of V.M.S. 3155, in the northwest line of V.M.S. 3160, and at the northernmost corner of said 84.11 acre tract, said point bears North 57°29'17" East 53.22 feet from a 5/8 inch iron pin found;

Thence **South 57°29'17" West 3125.47 feet**, departing from the centerline of Big Darby Creek and the southwest line of said 74.837 acre tract, following the southeast line of V.M.S. 3155, the northwest line V.M.S. 3160, the southeast line of said 113.0 acre tract, and the northwest line of said 84.11 acre tract, passing a 5/8 inch iron pin found at 53.22 feet and an iron pin set at 3095.38 feet, to the **place of beginning, containing 112.220 acres**, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above-described 112.220 acre tract of land, 1.031 acres are within the road right-of-way of County Road 153.

The above description was prepared from an actual field survey made by George A. Blackburn, Registered Surveyor #7873, during the month of November 2006. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch by 30 inch reinforcing rods with plastic caps marked "Blackburn RS #7873." Bearings indicated herein are based on the centerline of County Road 153 (60 feet wide) bearing North 37°00'00" West.
