thence along the southeast line of Patrick's 30.00 and 45.00 acre tracts, S 51° -39' W, 319.56 feet to the PLACE of BEGINNING.


The above described tract of land contains 0.38 acre of which 0.15 acre is dedicated for highway purposes.
