thence North 44°10'47" West 254.78 feet to an iron pin set;

thence North 32°57'14" East 197.42 feet, passing at 167.39 feet an iron pin set, to a railroad spike set in the centerline of County Road #153 and the east line of said 48.5 acre tract, said spike being South 59°45'00" East 268.01 feet from a railroad spike found at the northeast corner of said 48.5 acre tract;

thence South 59°45'00" East 270.78 feet, following the centerline of County Road #153 and the east line of said 48.5 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 1.388 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 1.388 acre tract, 0.193 acres is within the road right of way.


