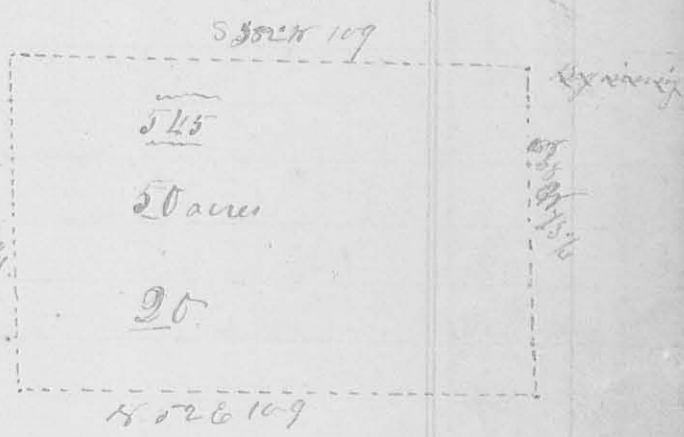

9th mo. (Sept. 26th 1823) Survey N^o 20. (8171)

Surveyed 50 acres of land for Joseph Stokes; beginning at 3 buckeyes from one root of the trunks are some decayed, I marked 2 black ash, all standing on the east bank of Beaver run of Darby's creek the north east corner of George McBride's survey $N 31^{\circ} 5'$ thence $\{begin\}$ $S 35^{\circ} E$ with the east line of McBride's said survey $73\frac{1}{4}$ poles to an ash tree, and buckeye thence $N 52^{\circ} E 109$ poles to 2 beeches and sugar tree, thence $N 38^{\circ} W 73\frac{1}{4}$ poles to 2 sugar trees and a bush in the north line of Levi's survey $N 52^{\circ} E$ - thence with said line $N 52^{\circ} W 109$ poles to the beginning containing 50 acres in the north west corner of Thomas Leas survey $N 52^{\circ} E$ on the waters of Darby's creek - $42'$ easterly from the original line allowed.



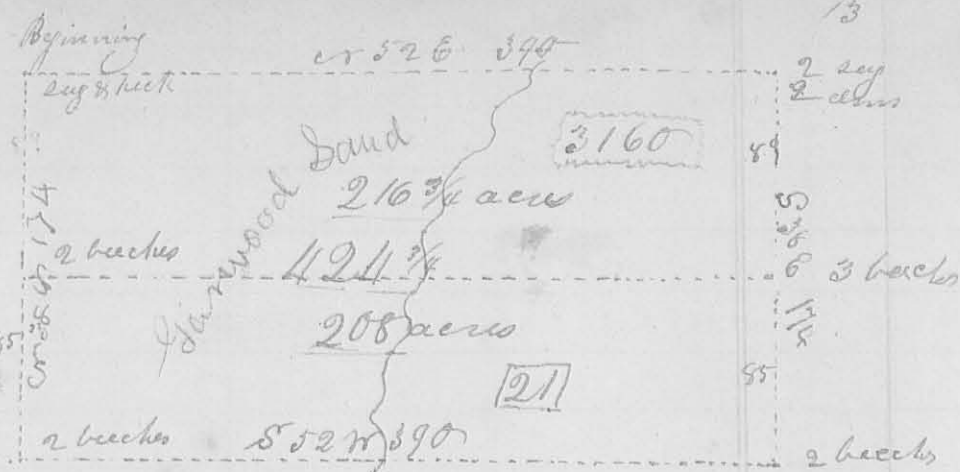

9th mo. (Sept. 26th 27th 1823) Survey N^o 21. (8172)

Surveyed and divided 42 1/2 acres of land for Jose H. Garwood beginning at the south west corner of George McBride's survey $N 31^{\circ} 5'$, originally 2 buckeyes, they being dead a sugar tree and hickory marked, thence $N 25^{\circ} 28' 20''$ poles crossing beaver run of Darby's creek at 25 to 2 sugar trees and 2 elms easterly to McBride's said survey, thence $S 38^{\circ} E 124$ poles to 2 beeches easterly corner to Levi Hollinsworth's survey $N 31^{\circ} 5'$ thence $N 52^{\circ} W 390$ poles (crossing said branch at 2 3/4 poles to

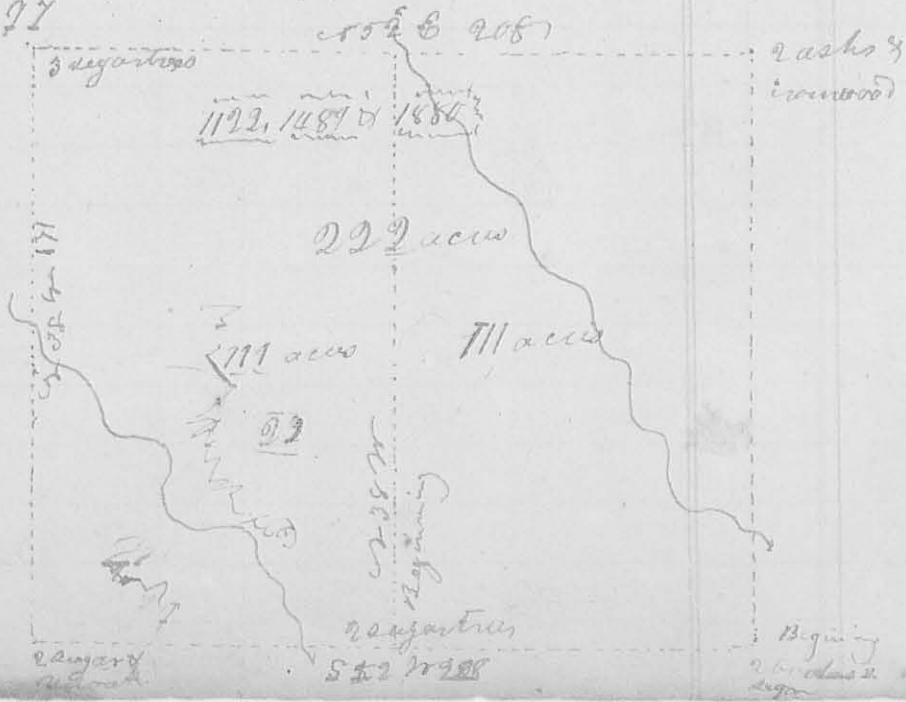

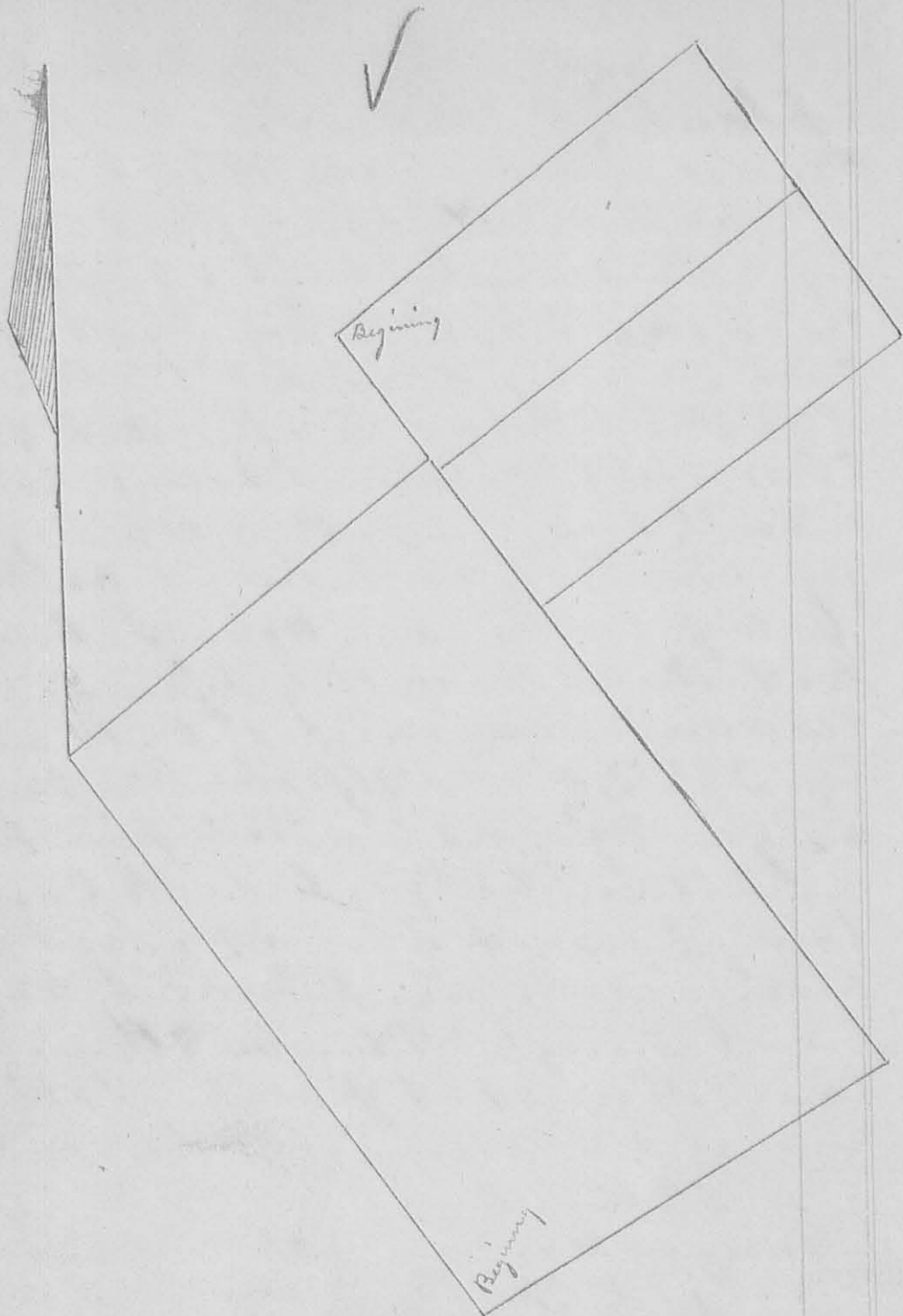

than B Garwood being acknowledged
I proceeded to make the survey as follows
Jesse H Garwood first being first duly
sworn in behalf of Jesse Warner and
others made answer to the following ques-
tions as follows

1 Do you know the South West corner of
Survey or 3155, Entered in the name of Geo-
rge McCreadis, & if so point out and
state by what means you ascertained it to
be such?

As Administrator of David Garwood's
Estate I employed J W Marmon, County
Surveyor, on Sept 25 1823 and by the entire
Survey of Survey or 3160 ascertained the
Corner to be near two Elms ^{now} standing (one dead)
Q How far do you think the corner to be from
the dead Elm?

I think it is about six links North of the
dead Elm.

J W Garwood
John Sharp jr being first duly sworn in
behalf of Jesse Warner & others made an-
swer to the following questions as follows

1 Do you know where the South East
corner of Survey or 3155 is, and if so point
it out and describe it?

Said corner was marked on two Sugars
and an Elm and I think from the position
of the trees that the corner was about
7 links S from dead Elm

2 By what means did you ascertain
this to be the corner?

I was Chain Carrier for J W Marmon
when said corner was established

In Accordance with the above Evidence began
 as above described and ran N 58 E passing
 Swamers corner at 111 poles and John Smith's
 corner at 112 1/2 poles crossing flat branch
 at 138 poles, 221 poles to point agreed upon
 by parties present; and ascertained by course
 and distance of this and the next line to be the
 corner. Planted stone. Present Isaac, Jere
 & David Warner, Wm Witterly, James and
 John Edwards, then S 35 1/2 E crossing ^{plantation} Middleburg
 road at 178 poles 343 1/2 poles to a stake in
 the east line of Thomas Sears Survey. Present
 Jesse, Isaac & David Warners, James Edwards
 and John Ballinger, then S 53 W 218 poles
 to an ash Buck-eye & Elm, Planted Stone
 Present Jesse, Isaac & David Warners
 Lashna Ballinger and James Edwards, then
 S 37 E 328 poles to the Beginning contain-
 ing 459 1/2 poles

At the same time Surveyed for John Ball-
 inger and James Edwards the following ad-
 joining lands. Beginning at corner of Thomas
 Sears Survey (which corner was ascertained
 by the course and distance N 53 E 218 poles
 from 3 Buck Eyes and two black ash (one gone)
 on the east bank of River run being the east-
 erly corner of Philip Slaughters Survey or
 3154 and corner to George Mc Creadies Survey
 or 3155, to point where planted stone.
 Lashna Ballinger, John Ballinger, James &
 John Edwards, present.) and run N 57 21 E
 crossing flat branch at 31 poles 213 poles
 to Red Oak, Sugar and Hickory, (Sugar and
 some appearance of Hickory left) Planted Stone

Planted stam present A Cr, David and
 Jesse Warner, Jas. Edwards John & Joshua
 Ballinger then S 35 1/2 E 16 1/2 poles to 2 Iron
 Woods & Beech (Beech gone and one Iron wood
 down) then S 53° W 207 poles to a stake two
