- September 24, 2026 (Thursday) **VILLAGE** - Final 2027 OPWC paperwork submitted to The Logan County Engineer's Office **COMPLETED** and **SIGNED** as follows:

 - CFO – Certification of Local Funds

 - **Each Village will be required to commit a minimum 10% of its estimated work from local funds**
 - **These OPWC grant funds can only be used for Village roadway paving and associate work related to the completion of said operations**
 - **Private funding cannot be combined with OPWC funding within this program.**

2027 General Guidance and Estimating Examples

General guidance

- #402 LVT is an Intermediate Course; LCEO recommends immediately applying a surface course after applying #402 LVT.
- #404 LVT is a Surface Course.
- LCEO recommends installing butt joints as feather joints can deteriorate quickly.
- LCEO recommends applying rejuvenating sealer to newly paved roads.

Milling

- Any milling to be done under the Village OPWC Contract must be done by entire streets.
- Localized milling will need to be arranged and contracted by the village.

Rejuvenating sealer

- A spray of cationic rejuvenating agent composed of petroleum resin oils and water applied to the road surface.
- Seals hairline cracks, restores oxidized components of asphalt, improves flexibility of asphalt, and extends the life of the pavement.
- Performed by a contractor (contractor also performs traffic control)
- Estimated at \$1.31 per square yard.

Estimating examples

- Prices are based on 2026 construction using ODOT's forecast of a 6.0% increase from 2025 pricing.
- All below examples are based on using a sample road section that is 1 mile long and 15' wide.

#402 LVT: \$116.00/TON: Apply 2" of 402 LVT: $[5,280' \times 15' \times (2''/12)]/27 \times 2 \text{ TON/CY} = 978$
TON ▶ 978 TON x \$116.00/TON = \$113,448

#404 LVT: \$115.00/TON: Apply 1.5" of 404 LVT: $[5,280' \times 15' \times (1.5''/12)]/27 \times 2 \text{ TON/CY} = 734$
TON ▶ 734 TON x \$115.00/TON = \$84,410

Milling: \$11.50/Sq. Yd: $[(5,280' \times 15')/9] = 8,800 \text{ Sq. Yd.} \times \$11.50/\text{Sq. Yd.} = \$101,200$

Each milled butt joint = \$505

#617 berm, Type A: \$55.00/ton: 2' x 2" berm on both sides: $[5,280' \times 2' \times (2''/12)]/27 \times 2 \text{ TON/CY}$
= 133 TON per side. 133 TON x 2 sides = 266 ton ▶ 266 TON x \$55.00/ton = \$14,630

Rejuvenating sealer: \$1.31/Sq. Yd: $[(5,280' \times 15')/9] = 8,800 \text{ Sq. Yd.} \times \$1.31/\text{Sq. Yd.} = \$11,528$
